Introduction

The Directorate of Women and Child Development is the nodal Department for ensuring a state of well being for women and children of Karnataka. The Directorate formulates action plans, policies and programmes towards achieving this mission, guides and co-ordinates the efforts of governmental and non-governmental organisations working for the empowerment of women and development of children. The two primary focus areas of government are ensuring nutritional standards and early childhood education. While many of the schemes, programmes and services are provided by the government the partnership with civil society organisations and private sector has enabled greater reach to women and children in need of care and support.

Vision To ensure that all women in Karnataka become economically, socially and politically empowered, and all children in the state get the care and protection that is needed for a safe and healthy childhood, thereby laying the foundation to pursue a promising future.

- To provide the necessary institutional mechanisms and financial support for the economic and social empowerment of women.
 - To prioritise women and child health, through effective implementation of the ICDS scheme and effective co-ordination with associated departments
 - To enable empowerment of women through awareness generation, education, access to credit, enforcement of legislations, greater emphasis on education, skill development, MICRO capacity building and income generating activities so as to enable women to enhance their earning capacity and economic status.
 - To implement central and state government programmes and schemes to guarantee the rights of children' including their survival, development and full participation in social, cultural, educational and other endeavours for their individual growth and well being.
 - To assist women who are victims of atrocities and in difficult circumstances, to ensure effective enforcement and implementation of the various central and state legislations and Acts to safeguard the rights of women and children and to achieve equality and justice in society
 - To promote and assist the voluntary and non-government sector to participate and contribute significantly in implementation of policies and programmes for women and children.

Purpose of Citizens Charter

The basic objective of this citizen's charter is to educate and empower the citizens in relation to the public service delivery rendered by the Directorate of Women and Child Development. This document declares the intention and the commitment of DWCD for providing quality care and efficient services, taking into account the requirements and expectations of women and children while also maintaining standards of services. The citizen's charter is a document that

- Communicates the services, programs and schemes for women and children implemented by the Directorate
- Specifies what standards can be expected from the services
- Provides details on the grievance redressal mechanisms
- Increases transparency of norms, processes and procedures operating in the Directorate
- Provides details on the individual and institutional responsibility for services being rendered
- Indicates the conditions the public need to fulfil in order to avail the services
- Serves as a resource directory providing information on the services, finance and budgets, procedures, personnel and contact persons from head office to the field level, responsible for implementing the charter and providing quality service to the women and children of the state.

Complaints and Grievance Redressal Procedure

Complaints are an expression of dissatisfaction, oral or in writing, about the service or actions of an agency or its staff. DWCD is implementing a convenient and efficient grievance redress process, which is based on the Sevottam standard (IS 15700:2005).

What is a complaint?

Public complaints may include complaints made by members of the public/ beneficiaries on their dissatisfaction with any service delivery process including administrative action such as:

- Unjust/ not in accordance with the existing laws and regulations,
- Causing excessive delays in service delivery,

- Abuse of power,
- Mal administration
- Ineffective service delivery,
- Lack of transparency and discrimination in the delivery of the services.
- Service devoid of courtesy and human touch

How can complaints be made?

- Complainant details including the name of a contact person, address, phone number and email address
- Details of the problem encountered including the date the problem occurred
- Provide suggestions to improve services at AWC

To assist in lodging a complaint, the Complaints form can be taken from AWC/BVS or GP. Alternatively, the complaints form can be taken from CDPO office.
